The Museum

Seashore Trolley Museum, tucked away in a beautiful wooded area within 5 miles of the coast of Maine, began the streetcar preservation movement in 1939. Today, our collection represents the evolution of transportation in New England, the United States, and the world, and includes omnibus, electric streetcars, trackless trolleys, buses, rapid transit cars and light rail vehicles. There are over 325 transit vehicles in our collection, in addition to thousands of historical transit artifacts.

We are open 10AM-5PM every Thursday through Sunday from Memorial Day through Halloween, and the first three weekends in December. We have a great Gift Shop, three picnic areas, and we are dog friendly!

The Ride

A visit to the Museum isn't complete without a memorable ride on an antique streetcar on our private heritage railroad. Engaging, uniformed crews ensure guests have an experience they will not soon forget. They will share information about the collection, the railway, the Museum, and welcome any questions.

Built on the roadbed of the former Atlantic Shore Line, an interurban line that operated from 1902-1927, our track now extends 1.7 miles (so over 3 miles roundtrip). Our track infrastructure and overhead wire was built and is maintained by volunteers.

Exhibits & Displays

Guests are treated to exhibits and displays of our collection throughout our grounds that demonstrate the role transportation played in shaping our country and the world .

Three Carbarns house over thirty unique, restored historic transit vehicles. The Town House Restoration Shop Gallery gives guests a bird's eye view of the streetcars undergoing restoration work. The Visitor Center Exhibit Room features "History in Motion: Public Transportation Connecting Maine Communities."

Programs

Our Calendar of Special Events is developed with families, adults, and railfans in mind. We host both recurring annual favorites and new events each year.

In 2021, we will be holding Story Time every weekday beginning July 12 through the end of August. Other invents include Daniel Tiger Comes to Seashore, appreciation days, Pumpkin Patch Trolley, and more.
